He is an Assistant Professor of Orthopedic Surgery at New York University School of Medicine and Chief of Adult Reconstruction Surgery at Bellevue Hospital, New York, NY. He obtained his Medical Diploma degree at University of Athens Medical School, Greece, his Masters of Science in Health Care Administration at University of Athens, Greece, his PhD in Orthopaedics at University of Thessalia, Greece, and his specialty in Orthopaedics at University Hospital of Larissa, University of Thessalia, Greece. He completed his fellowship in Musculoskeletal Infections and Orthopaedic Trauma at the University of Southern California, Keck School of Medicine, Los Angeles, CA, and Adult Reconstruction and Joint Replacement and Hip Arthroscopy - Hip Preservation Surgery at Hospital for Special Surgery, New York, NY. Dr. Poultsides worked as an Assistant Scientist at the Hospital for Special Surgery. He has published more than 120 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters and presented more than 250 papers in national and international meetings. His main areas of clinical research and interest are minimally invasive hip and knee surgery, and perioperative outcomes following primary and revision total hip and knee arthroplasty and hip preservation surgery.
