

Mark Rickman is a highly experienced Orthopaedic and trauma surgeon and a leading pelvic trauma surgeon. Prof Rickman trained in Oxford England, before completing his fellowships in Adelaide in 2004 and Bristol in 2005. He then worked in London for 10 years at St George's Hospital, one of London's four Major Trauma Centres, where he was Head of Department. In 2015 he relocated to Australia and is now permanently based in Adelaide as Director of Orthopaedic Trauma at the New Royal Adelaide Hospital. Mark is a renowned expert in Orthopaedic surgery and regularly teaches on Orthopaedic courses around the world. He holds a post at the University of Adelaide and is currently running several clinical trials as well as phase 2 and 3 interventional drug trials. He has 2 clinical trauma fellows, as well as a number of PhD students, covering several research topics in both trauma and elective Orthopaedics.
